The Open Day held for the parents of selected students on 31st of August was to separately
intimate to the parents that they are required to spend qualitative time with their wards

or reading the class lessons at home.

- Parents of the Primary Section are given an opportunity to listen to the Public Speaking Skill of their ward in the school. Accordingly, the class is divided into four batches. Parents must see the schedule and guide their ward for the event.
- Ensure that your ward attends the school regularly unless he/she is seriously sick. Students who attend the school irregularly are found weak in academics.
- September 05 and 06 will be a holiday for the students on account of Teachers' Day. September 07 will be a holiday on account of Ganesh Chaturthi.
- I appreciate the students who have authored 28 books this academic year. This is to develop the writing and presentation skills of the students. The articles and drawings in the books are written and presented in the school itself to promote authenticity and originality. Parents will be given an opportunity to look into the books written by our students in the school.
