October 15, 2024

1. October 17, will be a holiday on account of Valmiki Jayanthi.
2. Solo singing, Solo dance and Instrumental music competitions will be held for those students registered on 30th of October. Details of the events will be communicated to the participants by the respective teachers.
3. Open day for the KG Section and all Classes will be held on October 26th. Students in the High School Section will be exhibiting their Science Day Project for the parents on the Open Day.
4. Junior Orator Phase II for the Primary Section will begin from October 18th. Parents are requested to strictly follow the schedule given in the circular dated September 24th. Ensure that the child's performance will be better than the first one. The event will be held in the Hall of Peace. Parents must come only on the day when their child performs.
5. Parents will be given the Public Speaking Report Card of their ward on the Open Day. For Classes I to IV, the assessment will be done by parents and teacher. Parents will provide feedback based on their observations of their child's speaking abilities in the school (Junior Orator Events) and at home.

For Classes V to X, the assessment will include evaluation from both the student and teacher. Students will self-assess their performance and reflect on their strengths and areas for improvement, while teachers will provide their evaluations based on observed performances in class and various events in the school.

6. Hearty congratulations to the students who submitted the vacation homework to the class teachers. Students have done well. Their efforts will be published in the form of books authored by students. Parents will be able to view them on the Open Day. I observed that some parents have written the article, and not the child especially in the Primary Section. Such parents will be asked to pay ₹ 1,000/- for doing so.

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7. A motivational movie in Kannada will be screened for classes VII to X in St. Francis PU College Theatre on October 18, 2024.
8. Stringent disciplinary action will be taken against boys who come to school with haircuts that violate school policy.
