- There are some students who report to school late regularly. It disrupts the flow of the school assembly and erode class morale. I request the concerned parents to look into this very seriously and teach the children about time and punctuality. Children are expected to be in the school at 8·20 am.
- There are two activities scheduled for every Formative Assessment. Students are intimated about the activities for FA II and the same with details are uploaded in the school website for you to ensure that the students complete the activity within the given time.
- Home work is scheduled for all classes and the details are uploaded in the school website. Please follow the given instruction regarding the homework.
- Parents must ensure that the children cultivate the habit of reading and revising the day's lessons daily at home along with doing the homework.
- Every parent must spend quality time with the children at home. Please be reminded that it has a positive effect on the children especially in their academics as they grow.
- I request the parents to kindly check the class notes regularly and ensure that the notes are updated. Check the handbook of students regularly. It truly matters please.
- Make sure that the children come to school in complete uniform as specified by the school. A few students are found wearing shoes of different pattern and colour.
- The distribution of uniform/s, handbook and ID, was delayed this year due to closure of school and uncertainty of re-opening the school. The distribution of pullover will be delayed further and the delay is regretted.
- Kindly teach children to respect and take care of the safety of every other child in the class/school. Teach children about soft skills and solving skills when they encounter behavioural issues from others, because the physical and mental wellbeing of our children in the school are also our major concerns. This is my request to all the parents especially in the Primary Section.
- Students will be having their snacks in their own respective class along with their teacher for some reasons with effect from Monday, July 18. Students are not permitted to go to the canteen for snacks. Provide home food and avoid giving junk food to the children.
- Parents who change their contact number must inform the school office, if not, the school will not be responsible if communication fails in the event of emergency.

• The School has not made increment of School Fees for the past three academic years. The fees of the academic year 2020-21 remains the same for the current academic year, yet, it is sad to observe that a few parents have not yet cleared the dues of last year and also not paid the First Installment of this year irrespective of several reminders. The non-response of such parents is seriously monitored.
